

Always Improving




Keeping Fit & Active

Rise have taken the home by storm. This is a sport based competitive activity for group games, where the winners receive a trophy and compete with each other. It's very loud, very energetic and the home is filled with so much laughter. Rise come every week and on alternate weeks they provide 1:1 support to residents who may not be able to join a group setting for health reasons, for example nursed in bed. The RISE facilitator helps individual residents enjoy sport at their own individual level.



We have increased the physical exercise that we offer our residents by introducing RISE to our activity programme on a Tuesday. On Mondays, we continue to have Oscar. Oscar completes armchair exercise for our residents. This activity increases upper and lower body strength and helps improve stamina. We are currently linking this with residents who attend and analysing if we can reduce our residents falls.




Busy Activity Programme

We have had some brilliant live music, singing and dancing which helped us celebrate Valentine's Day, Mother's Day and other key days recently.




We continue with our pet therapy. Both our therapy dogs are trained to work with vulnerable individuals and our staff are aware of who likes a cuddle with our furry friends.



Night at the Ritz


By popular demand our activity team will be arranging another 'Night at the Ritz' for our residents.



Care Concern Group Award Night






