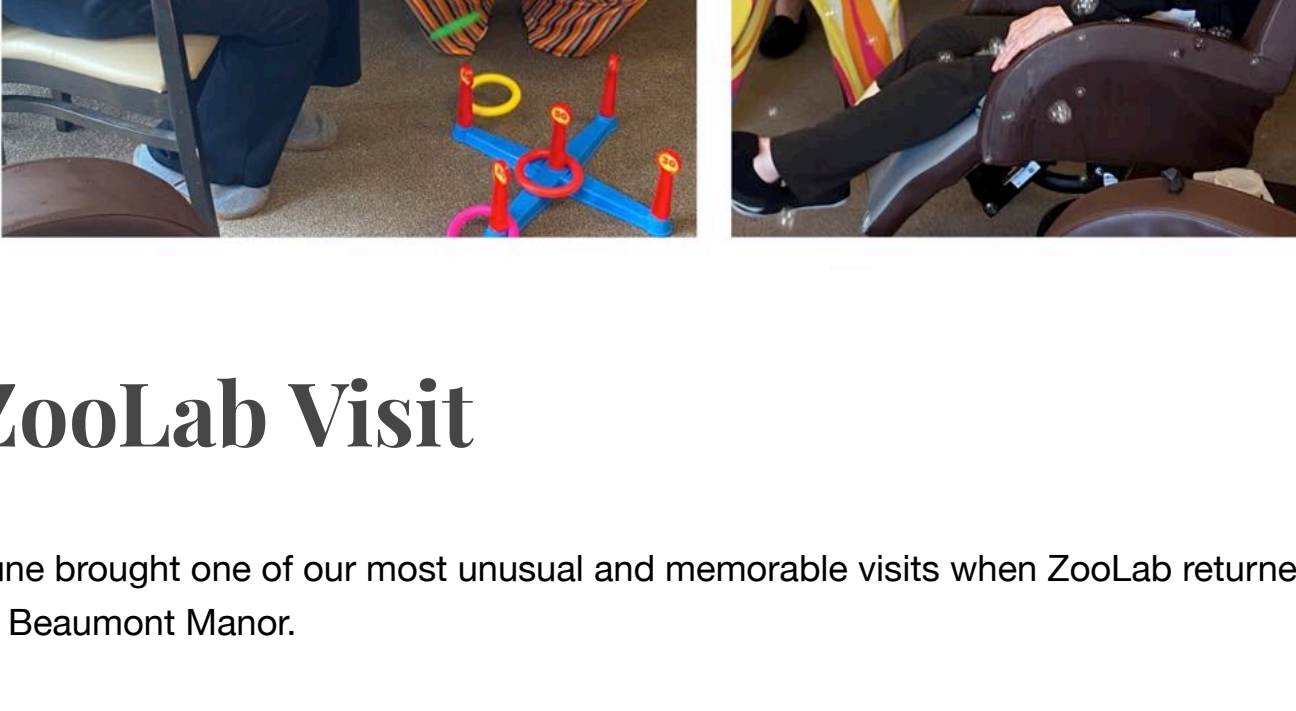
## ACTIVITIES & EVENTS

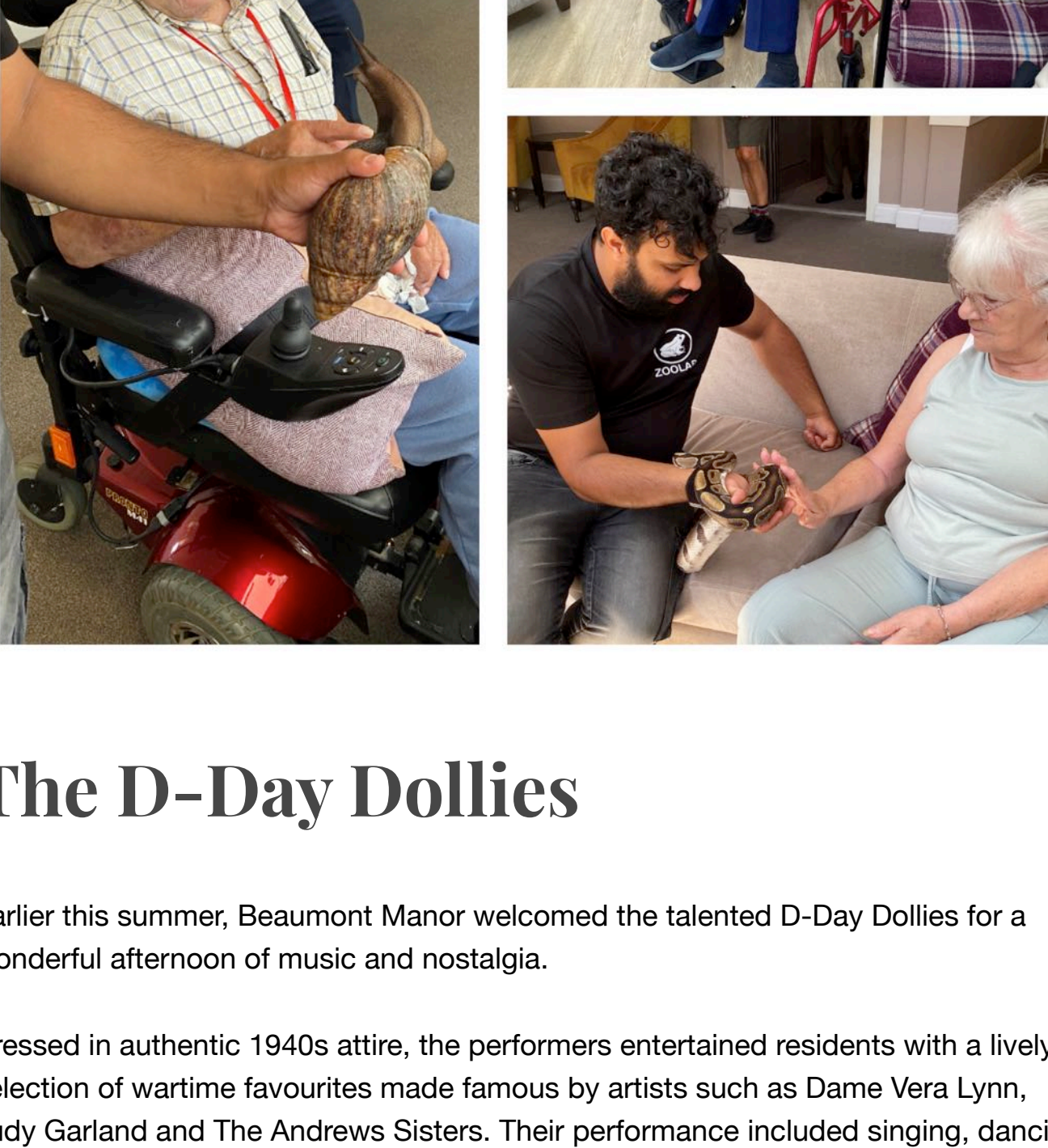
### ZooLab Visit

The D-Day Dollies will be returning later this summer, and we are already looking forward to welcoming them back.

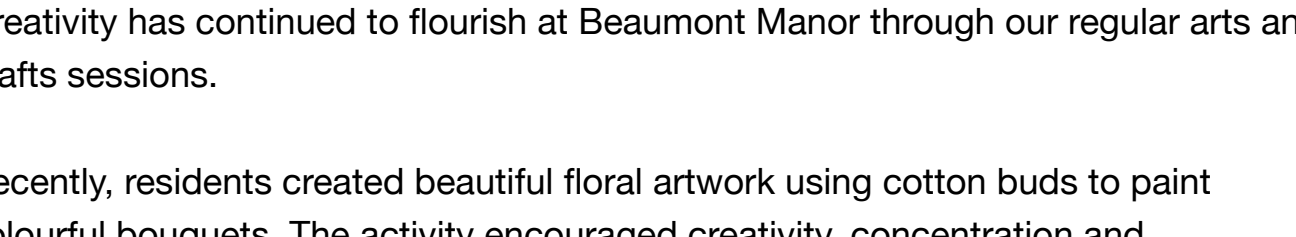


### Spring Craft Fair

The finished pieces brightened up the home and gave residents a real sense of achievement. It was lovely to see everyone enjoying the process and sharing ideas with one another.

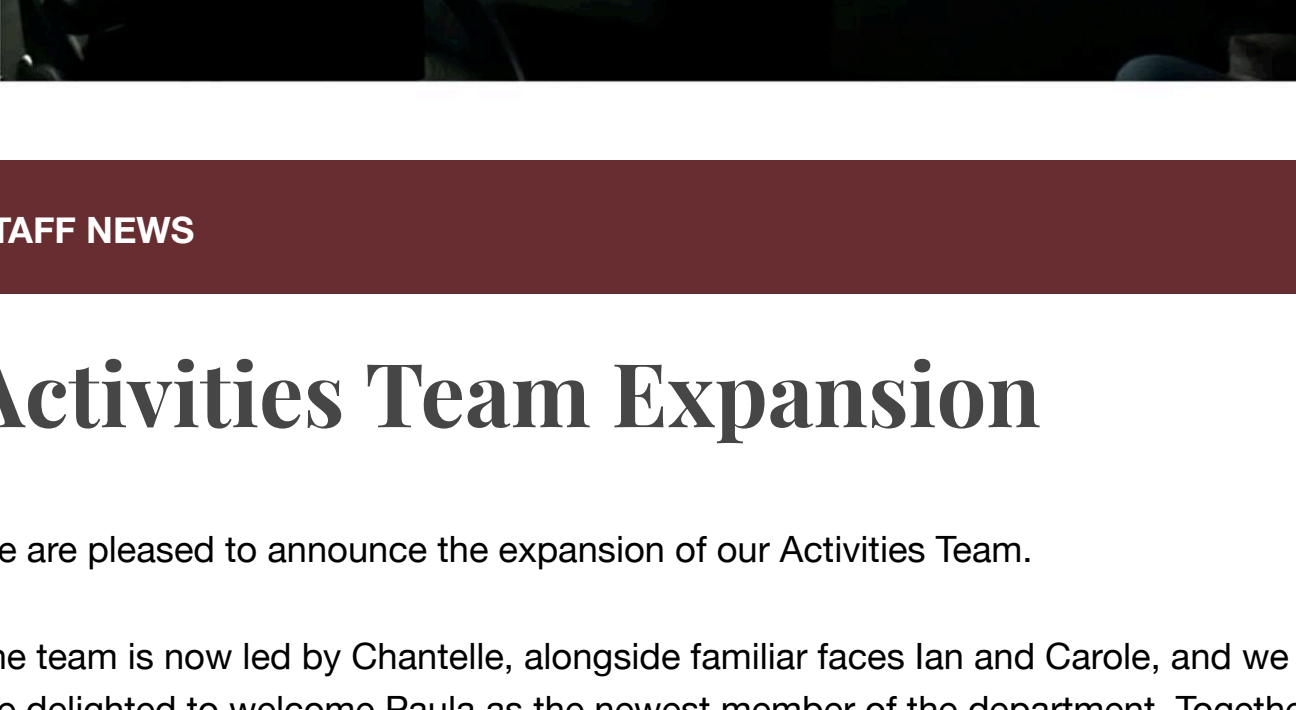


### Making the Most of Our Cinema

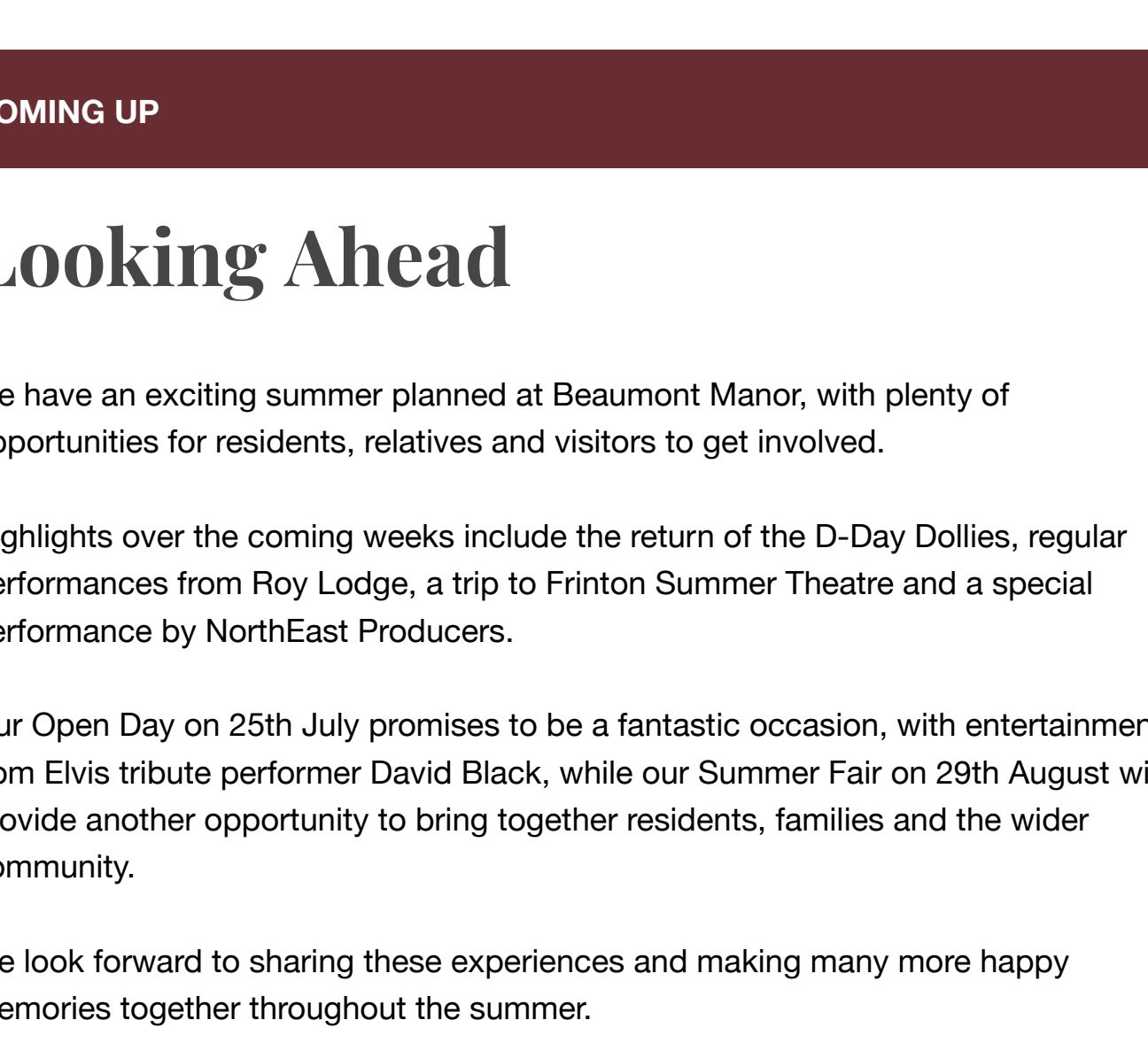
### Activities Team Expansion

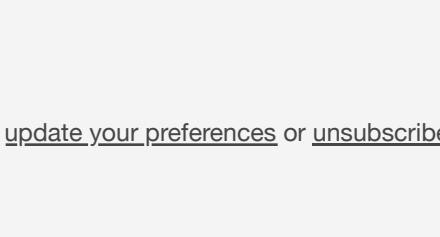

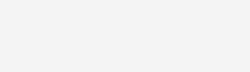
